

## Red Wine

### Spain

- \*Tempranillo, Castell Fuerte, Navarra** 24  
A superb grape variety used in Rioja wines. From the neighbouring region, Navarra, wines which gives a soft fruity wine with rounded structure.
- \*Rioja Crianza, Bodegas Ugalde Bianai, Rioja** 35  
This oak aged Rioja is a classic style with toasted aromas and great structure.
- \*Ribera, El Pedrosal Crianza, Ribera del Duero** 44  
From the top Ribera producer Perez Pascuas this wine is rated by Robert Parker at 91 points. A very high mark for a wine of this value.
- Rioja Seniorio Amezola Reserva, Rioja** 45  
This wine has a 91-point Robert Parker rating. A fine example of a quality Rioja.

### France

- \*Cabernet Sauvignon, Le Chapeau Noir, Languedoc** 26  
A gorgeous Cabernet with intense fruit tones. Flavours of blackcurrants with elegant tannins.
- \*Cotes du Ventoux, Les Pierres Blanches, Rhone** 31  
A classic blend of Grenache and Syrah from the Rhone Valley. Spicy undertones with great fruit.
- \*Pinot Noir, Antoine de la Farge, Loire** 39  
A beautiful fruit driven wine with an elegant finish. This Loire producer shows his passionate wine making skills and heritage.
- \*Chateau Tour Grand Mayne, Bordeaux** 39  
This award-winning wine is predominately Merlot based with a hint of Cabernet. It is oak aged and is very pleasant on the palate.
- Vacqueyras, Domaine Bonfils, Rhône** 40  
Grenache & Syrah blend from a select region in the Rhône Valley. Spice and Pepper tones abound. 12 months ageing in oak.
- Chateau Pailhas St. Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux** 55  
An Award-Winning wine this Merlot and Cabernet blend is the classic French Bordeaux style.
- Cotes du Beaune Village Louis Latour, Burgundy** 44  
From one of Burgundy's top producers this fine Pinot Noir is smooth and elegant.

### Italy

- \*Sangiovese, La Casada, Emilia Romagna** 25  
Cherry and Stone Fruit flavours this medium bodied fruity wine is perfect with most food pairings.
- Amarone della Valpolicella Masi, Veneto** 34  
Big full-bodied wine with generous fruit filled characteristics
- Neropasso, Biscardo, Veneto** 34  
A wonderful wine made in the Ripasso method is a blend of Cabernet and Corvina

### Argentina

- \*Malbec, Los Haroldos Chacabuco, Mendoza** 30  
The most famous wine from this region is a blend of Cabernet and Cinsault predominately. Harvested 000 meters above sea level. Soft and elegant with plum and cherry. Smooth tannins with a rounded finish.

### Lebanon

- Chateau Musar, Lebanon** 50  
There is a smoky, earthiness tone with great spice flavours.

### Rosé

- \*Domaine de l'herre Rose** 25  
Bursting with fruit, a very elegant rose

## White Wine

### Spain

- \*Albarino Alba Vega, Rueda** 39  
Silky and well-structured with pronounced fruit flavours.  
This in-vogue wine is a great example from a classic producer.

### France

- \*Sauvignon Blanc, Le Chapeau Noir, Languedoc** 26  
A typical Sauvignon with green grass and tropical fruit flavours. Well balanced acidity and clean finish.
- \*Chardonnay, Domaine l'Herre, Gascony** 28  
This unoaked wine is produced here in the Chablis style close to the Pyrenees Mountains. Cool mountain air creates the perfect Chardonnay grapes for this award-winning wine.
- \*Piquepoul, Henri Richemer, Languedoc** 30  
This high acidity wine from the lesser known Piquepoul varietal is similar in style to Sauvignon Blanc but adds a new dimension to the fruit character.
- \*Sauvignon Blanc, L'Enfant Rebelle, Loire** 38  
This wine features in the top 100 white wines of the world. From the area where the great Sancerre wines are produced this rebel performs.
- \*Petit Chablis, Domaine de la Cornasse, Burgundy** 44  
A great producer in this region producing classic Chardonnay wines.  
This wine is unoaked, crisp and clean and top quality.
- Menetou Salon, Domaine de Lermitege** 45  
Wonderful minerality with peach and exotic fruit tones from the neighbouring region to Sancerre. A wonderful Loire wine.
- Sancerre Vacheron Biodynamic, Loire** 50  
One of Sancerre's reknowned producers working. Steely and flinty with a long crisp clean finish.
- Chablis Premier Cru Louis Latour, Burgundy** 54  
Another top producer. This is one of the top Chablis wines.

### Germany

- Riesling Hocheimer Domdechant Werner, Rheingau** 54  
This wine producer recently won the best white wine maker in the world accolade.  
Medium dry in style with beautiful aromatic tones.

### Italy

- \*Pinot Grigio DOC Secolo, Veneto** 25  
Crisp dry and fruity with an easy drinking style. A quality wine from the north of Italy.
- Oropasso, Biscardo, Veneto** 34  
A unique blend of Chardonnay and Garganega grapes delivers a full flavoured delicious white.

### Argentina

- \*Chenin Blanc Chardonnay, Los Haroldos Waqi, Mendoza** 25  
Chenin Blanc grown in the hot climate of Argentina produces a very aromatic style.  
Hint of Chardonnay is blended in to balance the aromatics producing a lovely citrusy tropical wine.

### New Zealand

- \*Sauvignon Blanc, Matahiwi Estate, Wairarapa** 36  
Vibrant and aromatic with gooseberry and lime flavours

## Champagne & Sparkling

- \*Prosecco Frizzante** 28  
A light and fruity Italian with a delicate sparkle.
- \*Cremant de Bourgogne, Domaine Luquet** 45  
Bone dry with wonderful toasty aromas. Great fruit on the palate.
- Champagne Bruno Paillard Premiere Cuvee** 75  
Fresh and generous bouquet of ripe fruits. A particularly elegant champagne.
